ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE

Memory, visual/spatial, and language decline

- Influence
- Delusions
- Agitation
- Behavioral Changes



FRONTO-TEMPORAL DEMENTIA

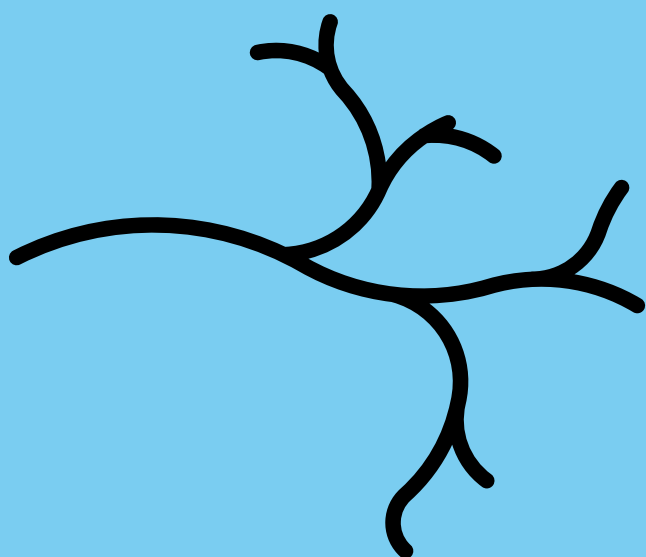
Personality changes

- Executive dysfunction
- Impulsivity
- Progressive loss of speech

LEWY BODY DEMENTIA*

Visual hallucinations

- Delusions
- Falls
- Syncope
- Parkinsonism
- Fluctuating memory
- Sensitivity to antipsychotic medication
- *includes PDD and DLB



VASCULAR DISEASE

Abrupt onset

- Stepwise deterioration
- Prominent aphasia
- Motor dysfunction
- Mood/behavior changes
- Severe depression
